Day one: Arrive Napier

Flat terrain: 50kms

80% onroad & off road pathways 20% on road way

The majority of the farmland you will be riding today came up from the sea bed after the 1931 earthquake. A picturesque Trail, lots to discover as you wind your way beside the Poraiti Foothills, through farmlands to the Ahuriri Wetlands where you will find wildlife a plenty, maybe see a plane or two landing at the Napier Airport. Two more Wetlands to cycle beside Westshore Wild Life Reserve and Watchman Road Reserve - stop of at the information panels explaining the incredible journeys of birds including the Godwits and Royal Spoonbills. Pass by the Napier Airport, Lagoon Farm - on arrival at the village of Bay View several orchards in this areas **Options:** Snapper Café or *Crab Farm Winery and Restaurant - cycle the coastal pathways via Beacons Reserve to the suburb of Westshore which takes you to the fishing village of Ahuriri. Stop of at the Urban Winery & National Distillery Company for a taste or two. View Art Deco buildings and maybe enjoy lunch at a café in the village. Continue on the pathway beside the sea to the inner city of Napier, lock your bikes and meander through the shopping centre taking time to look above the verandas to view the Art Deco buildings. Back onto the pathway along the Marine Parade turning inland and enjoy the new concrete iWay Pathways that takes you through Marewa and Tamatea Suburbs and detour to Park Island to enjoy the view

Cycle one way from Bike About Tours: 28kms,

This peaceful country ride is predominantly on pathways beside the sea as well as three river bank pathways, very scenic and ideal for families: On arrival at Awatoto beside the sea follow the Pathway through the Waitangi Estuary, this 240 ha of wetland is where Muddy Creek, Ngaruroro, Tutaekuri and Clive Rivers meet the sea. The area provides a variety of wetland and coastal habitats that support a significant population of bird species, including heron and bittern, similar to that of the nearby Tukituki Estuary which you will cycle through between the Village of Clive to Black Bridge. Cross the bridge turning left toward the sea cycling the riverbank pathway to Haumoana village, maybe stop of for an ice cream at Village Store – approx. 3 kms of cycling time to explore wineries. *Note: Winter months not always open* - Beach House Wines*, Elephant Hill Winery, Clearview Winery*, Te Awanga Estate*. Cycle through the Te Awanga Village, at road end you will find Wool World* and Hygge Café* beside the sea. Other options: British Car Museum, Hawke Bay Farmyard Zoo, numerous Art & Craft studios in this area. Afternoon collection:

Day Five: Puketapu Loop - Wine Ale & Cider & Chocolates

Flat terrain: Approximately 37 km ride

80% Onroad & off road pathways 20% on road

Connect mind body and soul and enjoy nature's peaceful surroundings as you cycle this amazing area close by our base at Greenmeadows. A short ride to Mission Estate and Church Road Wineries, both offer wine tasting, lunch and a range of tours to learn about the wine making process. Continue your ride through the suburb of Taradale stopping of at the popular local pub Duke of Gloucester Bar and Restaurant, then to Otatara Maori Pa Sit which is worthy of a visit, excellent history board and lookout. Then to Silky Oak Chocolates Company - Café - Museum and a viewing window where the chocolates are made. Back track and join the Riverbank Pathway which takes you into the countryside passing by vineyards, orchards and farmlands. Maybe stop of at Moana Park Winery on way to the Puketapu Village. Puketapu Hotel is a great place to stop for a beer, cider, wine etc and met the locals – they offer food for all occasions! maybe an ice cream at the local dairy or walk around the Historic Church or try out the flying fox. To complete the loop cross the one way bridge turn left and cycle the Omarunui River Bank Pathway - several gates to open, continue on the EIT Pathway to Guppy Road, turn left and head inland to Meeanee Road (right turn) which takes you to the Filter Room & Café – Boutique beer and cider made on site, during summer often open until late and you can get dinner here (closed Mon & Tues)

Section one: Ohiti Valley

Coach drop of Ohiti Road a fabulous country ride cycling through this picturesque valley floor is a sight to behold: you pass by rocky outcrops, farming flats; every bend the valley unfolds its secrets, and ever-changing panoramic vistas. A little way along the valley floor widens to a multitude of immaculate vineyards sheltered by the rolling hills and the high river stock bank on your left. You have the odd hill or two to climb, care needs to be taken when freewheeling downhill grades, and there are plenty of these. Morning tea/Lunch at *Unison Vineyard

Section two Gimblett Gravels & Bridge Pa Wineries – 10kms ride

This wine growing area covers 800ha, 90% of the land is planted in red grape varieties the other 10% white grape varieties. The handcrafted wines produced from 11 plus wineries in this area have won a multitude of Gold Medals & trophies. A wine lovers paradise that is full of surprises, a wide range of wine varieties for you to discover in your glass - that showcase the regions potential and growth. 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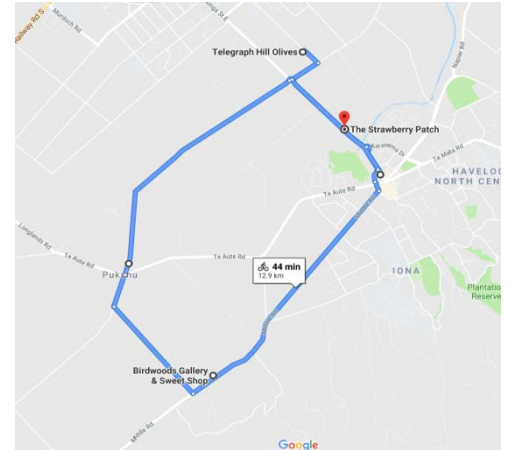

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Day Seven: **Day Four** **Birdwood Country Loop 10.3kms or 6.6kms there and back - afternoon free to explore**

From your accommodation in Havelock North you have a 3.3kms ride in the country to Birdwood Gallery & Café it is a 'must visit' for all visitors and locals, offering a gallery, sculpture garden, café, fruit ice creams and old fashioned sweet shop. www.birdwoodgallery.co.nz To ride the loop you have two quite country roads to meander along on your bike, School Road & Mt Erin Road. Take care crossing Te Aute Road onto St Georges Road – I suggest single file from here – most of the land in this area is orchards. You may like to have lunch at St Georges Restaurant, lots of places to explore along Havelock Road on your way back to Havelock North

Day Eight: **Tuki Tuki Valley**

37kms Drop off and collection Black Bridge

Note: Craggy Range is open every day for food – there is a small café just before Red Bridge cannot guarantee opening hours!

Venture inland on the Tuki Tuki Cycle Pathway following the River for approx. 6 kms. Roadway cycling from here on which has varied terrain and some on-road cycling lanes in various places. Meander along the flat terrain for several kms until you come to an area where you cycle downhill (extreme care biking from this point onwards - I suggest cycling single file) around interesting bends, then winding hills and gentle elevation as you pass by rolling country side, vineyards, orchards and farmlands. Stop and soak up the stunning panoramic views overlooking the Tuki Tuki River and the back drop of Te Mata Peak which is 399mts above sea level. At the bottom of the hill the road flattens out and have varied terrain in places. Cross Red Bridge (no clip on bridge for cyclists) a little way along is an avenue of young Oak trees then a hilly section on way to Craggy Range Winery & Restaurant, from here on your left a new section of cycle pathway beside the road is in the planning - until it is completed extreme care must be taken - single file please! You have a 2.6kms section that uphill, and a very narrow road. Turn right onto River Road approximately 2kms down you will join the Tuki Tuki Riverbank Pathway a 7.7km ride to Black Bridge where you will be collect. - **well done you have cycled the loop**

Day Nine: **Clive iWay - Explore Hastings & Havelock North - Sundays only Farmers Market**

Flat terrain: 70% Onroad & off road pathways

One way from Bike About Tours base

31.8kms to Te Mata Estate Winery

19.8kms drop of at Awatoto beside the sea to Te Mata Estate

16.8kms drop of at Clive iWay to Te Mata Estate

A pleasant 2.7kms ramble along Guppy Road to join the Tutaekuri Riverbank Pathway then onto Awatoto beside the sea. From here you cross 3 bridges that take you over the Tutaekuri, Ngaruroro and Clive Rivers all with cycle lanes to the village of Clive. Continue on the pathway beside Clive's Main Road – 2kms down you will join the iWay pathway on your right - this ride takes you past the Clive River - through the small settlement of Whakatu beside the railway line. A great stop of for a breather is the Fire Station Bakery & Café you cannot miss it as it is painted red! Back onto the pathway where you view the commercial buildings, orchards and vineyards. Cross the wooden bridge that was built especially for the cyclist as you make your way directly to Hastings Show Grounds which is home to the Farmers Market every Sunday from 8.00am to 12.30pm. The atmosphere and friendly smiles from the locals and stall holders alike make this an amazing morning out, lots of samples given out to lure your taste buds. Heaps of exploring to do from here on - hanging baskets are a site to behold in Hastings town centre, Brave Brewing for a taste or two, Telegraph Hill for Olive Products, Strawberry Patch, Village of Havelock North lots of option for shopping and lunch... then onto Te Mata Mushrooms, Arataki Honey, Red Barrel Wines, Black Barn Winery & Kitchen, Te Mata Estate, Origin Earth for Cheese Afternoon collection
