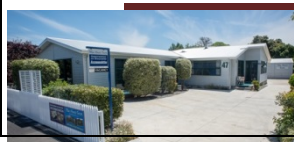

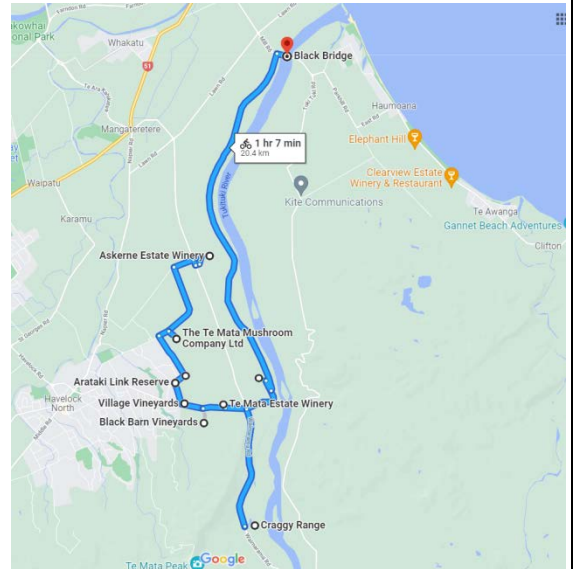

Trail 718: Havelock North Wineries

HIGHLIGHTS: Your cycling adventure from Askerene Estate to Arataki Link Reserve, you will enjoy meandering through quite country and village roads, passing by lots of new houses. On reaching Te Mata Road your cycling is mostly on designated off road pathways.

Flat terrain with a slight elevation when cycling through the picturesque outskirts of Havelock North Village, where you will find a cluster of 5 wineries and Arataki Honey Visitor Centre. Cycling the elevated new pathway to Craggy Range, magnificent views to your left overlooking the Tuki Tuki River, rolling hills, farmlands, horticulture, orchards, vineyards. Once on the flat pathway look up to right is the back drop of Te Mata Peak which is 399mts above sea level



You have the option of being collected at a place that suits you best, or continue your ride for 7.7kms along the Riverbank cycle pathway to Black Bridge for collection or continue back to our base in Greenmeadows – Napier

A little history...

Havelock North was founded by the government in the late 1860 to provide land for small farmers and working-class settlers. Like other towns in the region, its growth was restricted by large pastoral stations on its fringes. The first orchards appeared in the 1870s, but they were not common until the early 20th century. Bernard Chambers established the first vineyard (Te Mata Estate Winery) in 1892. Subdivision of pastoral land from 1898 enabled the town to expand. The township was named after British general Sir Henry Havelock to commemorate his role in suppressing a rebellion against British power in India.

The vineyard site was acquired in 1993 by John and Kathryn Loughlin, chosen for its mix of soils and particularly the very free-draining former river bed. The site had previously been used to grow asparagus and later as a stud farm for Texel sheep. The original block was 11 hectares. The first vines were planted in 1993. A new outdoor area is delightful for your delicious Gourmet Picnics: Put together your own combination from our selection of gourmet foods with one of our award-winning wines for a picnic in our idyllic vineyard setting

The first mushroom crop on the Brookvale Road farm was harvested from a boat shed in 1967; just a small part of the overall cropping operation run by newly formed Te Mata Nursery, by 1973 all other crops were phased out and in 1990 the company's name officially changed to Te Mata Mushrooms Ltd. You can call into their factory shop and purchase mushrooms – delicious!

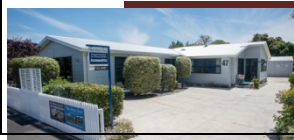
